RESOLUTION 2024-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE UTAH INLAND PORT AUTHORITY ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE VERK INDUSTRIAL PARK PROJECT AREA PLAN

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code §11-58-301(1) as amended ("UCA"), the Utah Inland Port Authority ("Authority") is "governed by a board which shall manage and conduct the business and affairs of the Authority"; and

WHEREAS, the Authority created a project area known as the Verk Industrial Park in Spanish Fork City to facilitate and fund regional economic development opportunities and maximize the long-term economic benefit of the region; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to UCA §11-58-504, the Authority may amend a project area plan; and

WHEREAS, the Authority board desires to amend the Verk Industrial Park Project Area, which was originally adopted on July 17, 2023 and adopt an updated project area plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE AUTHORITY BOARD as follows:

- 1. The Authority board has found and determined that the attached amendment to the Verk Industrial Park project area plan meets the statutory requirements set forth in UCA § 11-58-501(3) and includes:
 - a. the legal description of the boundary of the project area,
 - b. the purpose and intent with respect to the project area and the board's finding and determination that:
 - i. there is a need to effectuate a public purpose;
 - ii. there is a public benefit to the proposed Verk Industrial Park development project;
 - iii. it is economically sound and feasible to adopt and carry out the Verk Industrial Park project area plan; and
 - iv. carrying out the Verk Industrial Park project area plan will promote the goals and objectives stated in Subsection 11-58-203(1).
- 2. The Authority board hereby adopts the amendment of the Verk Industrial Park Project and accepts the boundary changes from Spanish Fork City; the update to expected trigger date; the addition of wetlands mitigation into allowable uses of tax differential; and the updated budget.
- 3. This Resolution is effective January 10, 2024, upon the affirmative vote of the Authority Board.
