CROSSING PID NO 1. & NO. 2 INTERLOCAL TAX SHARING AGREEMENT RESOLUTION NO. 2025-38

WHEREAS, pursuant to §11-58-301(1) Utah Code Annotated as amended ("UCA"), the Utah Inland Port Authority ("Authority") is "governed by a board which shall manage and conduct the business and affairs of the Authority"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Authority (the "Board") has previously approved the creation of the Skyline Corridor Project Area (the "Project Area") within Sanpete, Sevier, and Wayne counties during a meeting of the Board on October 7, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Board heretofore approved a Wetlands Policy reserving 1% of the tax differential for the associated project area shall go towards wetland mitigation during a meeting of the Board on November 6, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ephraim heretofore approved the creation of the Crossing Public Infrastructure District No. 1 & 2 (the "District") during a meeting of the Board on March 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Board and the District desire to enter into an agreement for Tax Differential Sharing;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD as follows:

- 1. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to execute the Interlocal Tax Sharing Agreement between the Authority and District with the following terms:
 - a. District will receive 80% of the Tax Differential received by the Authority; and
 - b. At minimum, 1% of the Tax Differential received by the Authority may used for wetlands mitigation pursuant to the UIPA BP-17 Wetland Policy
- 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately. The effective date of the Agreement shall be the date the last party to the Agreement executes the Agreement.
