As Chair and Vice-chair of the Inland Port Authority Board, we want to express our personal support of this funding request, and our intent to place this on the next board meeting agenda, November 26, 2018. The enabling legislation that created the Utah Inland Port Authority set aside \$4 million from the State to be matched by Salt Lake County with another \$4 million. The \$8 million total will be used to help with construction of 2550 South.

This project, which is a collaboration between UDOT, West Valley City and Salt Lake County/Magna Metro Township, will provide East-West access for the many import and export businesses located along the SR 201 Corridor without impacting adjacent residential communities. The links to Mountain View Corridor, 5600 West and 8000 West will provide a rapid route to major freeway systems.
